Discover Santa Fe with the personal touch of arts and culture in this first class tour. This tour features Allan Houser Sculpture Garden and Foundry, Santa Fe, Poeh Center, several culinary delights and more. Founded in 1610 at 7,000 feet, Santa Fe is considered both the highest and oldest capital city in America.



Day 1, Fly to Albuquerque, then have lunch at the famous El Pinto Restaurant - featured on MSNBC, Food Network and a local favorite of President George W. Bush. We will then have a private tour of the Albuquerque Museum's Historic Casa San Ysidro with Deb Slaney curator of history for the museum. After we will travel north to Santa Fe and check in to the Eldorado Hotel & Spa. We then have a welcome culinary experience dinner at the Santa Fe Cooking School. (L,D)

Day 2, After breakfast, we will visit the Allan Houser's Sculpture Garden and foundry. Recognized as one of the most important American artists of the 20th Century, Allan Houser has left a lasting legacy for future generations. Renowned as a sculptor, painter, and teacher, his work is featured in museums, private and corporate collections throughout the world. Followed by a catered lunch on the grounds. Upon returning to the Santa Fe, we will have a private reception at the Blue Rain Gallery, with well-known ceramic artist and sculptor Tammy Garcia. The rest of the evening yours to relax, shop and explore Old Town Santa Fe with its many shops, galleries and museums and the Governors Palace. (B,L)

Day 3 After breakfast, we will visit the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum with a tour by curator Carolyn Kastner. You will then have time for lunch and shopping in the Old Town area. This afternoon we will travel to the Tower Gallery at Poeh Center on the Pueblo of Pojoaque to meet with Roxanne Swentzell. Before returning to Santa Fe we will have a farewell dinner at Rancho de Chimayó. (B,D)

Day 4 After breakfast, we will visit the Rio Grande Botanical Gardens with a special Art and Garden Design tour with the Executive Director and a Plant Curator. We will have lunch before heading to the airport for your return flight back home. (B,L)

Heard Museum Curator of Collections Diana Pardue and the Desert Botanical Gardens Onsite Public Programs Manager Steen Allard-Lawson will be escorting this tour. This tour includes round trip air from Phoenix and transportation while on tour, 3 nights' accommodations in Santa Fe, all attractions, meals and tours listed in the itinerary, minimum gratuities and portage. There will be some walking required on uneven ground and stairs, this is not a wheelchair accessible tour.

Full refund, less the \$100 processing fee if canceled before March 1, 2010. No refund for no-shows or cancellations after March 1, 2010. Deposits of \$400 per person are being accepted to confirm your reservation. The deposit includes a processing fee of \$100 by the Desert Botanical Gardens or Heard Museum.
